Future plan

Expansion of the services requires additional resources. This eventually leads to seeking external support in the form of expertise and money.

Achieved success in running classless effectively.

Branch out geographically extending their service to other areas for children from the same community or expand their range of services by forming links with other initiatives.

The value of mother tongue and supplementary education cannot be underestimated. The strong cultural input, including lessons in history and culture, give children a real sense of their position in society. As such, supplementary and mother tongue schools reinforce and enhance the mainstream education.

Give general support with schoolwork in English, maths and science. Run youth programmes with activities in sport and arts. Run lessons in community languages, and teach children about their culture and history.
